

How to travel with cats in a car long distance

Checklist

Get Organized

- Plan out your trip route; adding rest stops, hotel arrangements (make sure the hotel is pet-friendly)
- Come up with a contingency plan in case Plan A self-destructs
- Buy a cat carrier; make sure it's large enough so the cat(s) are comfortable (Recommendation: PetLuv Premium Cat Carrier - <https://amzn.to/2MZmAKI>)

Prepare for the Trip

- Line the cat carrier with litter pads, cat's favorite blanket. Add the cat's food bowl and favorite toys
- Make sure to bring cat litter and disposable cat litter pans
- Prepare a cat travel bag with cat food, snacks, bottles of water, extra litter pads and baby wipes

Prepare the Car

- Pack the car; make sure there's plenty of space for the cat carrier. If using sedation, sedate the cats.
- Place cats in the car last.
